

BY-LAW NO. 33-13

OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF AYLMER

**Being a By-Law to amend By-Law 52-05 with respect
to the procurement of goods and services**

WHEREAS, Part 1 of the Ontario Regulation 191/11, 5. (1) Provides that the Government of Ontario, Legislative Assembly and designated public sector organizations shall incorporate accessibility criteria and features when procuring or acquiring goods, services or facilities, except where it is not practicable to do so;

WHEREAS, if the Government of Ontario, Legislative Assembly or a designated public sector organization determines that it is not practicable to incorporate accessibility criteria and features when procuring or acquiring goods, services or facilities, it shall provide, upon request, an explanation;

WHEREAS, the Government of Ontario, Legislative Assembly and designated public sector organizations shall meet the requirements of this section in accordance with the following schedule:

1. For the Government of Ontario and the Legislative Assembly, January 1, 2012.
2. For large designated public sector organizations, January 1, 2013.
3. For small designated public sector organizations, January 1, 2014.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council for the Town of Aylmer deems it expedient to amend the Town's Procurement Policy to recognize the accessibility requirements, by adding "Schedule B" to By-law 52-05.

**THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF AYLMER
HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That Schedule "A" attached to and forming part of this By-Law shall be "Schedule "B" of the Procurement Policy By-law 52-05 of the Corporation of the Town of Aylmer.
2. That this By-Law shall come into full force and effect upon passage of this by-law.

In keeping with Ontario Regulation 191/11 Integrated Accessibility Standards, General Requirements, The Town of Aylmer is committed to incorporating accessibility criteria and features when procuring or acquiring goods, services, or facilities. Accessibility criteria shall be considered when developing the design specifications for the procurement of any goods, services or facilities. When it is not practicable to do so, the Town shall document and provide an explanation, upon request.
