

BY-LAW NO.31 -76

OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF AYLMER

Being a by-law to set out regulations governing the maintenance and operation of municipal service club sign boards.

WHEREAS the Ministry of Transportation and Communications, in compliance with The Public Transportation and Highway Improvement Act, have granted permission to the Corporation for the continued encroachment of existing service club sign boards located at the highway approaches into the Town of Aylmer;

AND WHEREAS, the Municipal Council of the Town of Aylmer thereby assumes full responsibility for the said signs;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF AYLMER HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Council, or a Committee of Council, shall determine the number of group or organizational sign installations and the size and type of signs which shall be installed on the boards. Groups and organizations wishing to place a sign shall submit a letter of application to council. Selection shall be determined on a first come-first served basis until council deems the boards to be full.
2. Costs for maintenance and upkeep of the boards and signs shall be borne equally by those organizations represented.
3. The assessment for costs shall be submitted annually to the organization or groups.

The sign is subject to removal if assessment is not made within 60 days of billing.
