## **BY-LAW NO. 14-09**

## Being a By-Law to amend the composition of the Aylmer Heritage Committee

WHEREAS,	it is necessary to make certain amendments to	By-law	No.	39-05
with respect to th	ne composition of the Aylmer Heritage Committee;			

AND WHEREAS, Council did support the said amendments by Council Resolution No. 142-09 on March 16, 2009;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF AYLMER HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLOWS:

- 1. By-law No. 39-05 be amended to reflect:
  - (i) Paragraph 2 be deleted in its entirety and replaced with:

"The Aylmer Heritage Committee shall be composed of not fewer than Seven (7) members appointed by Council."

- (ii) Paragraph 3 be deleted in its entirety and replaced with:
  - "(a) That the membership shall consist of Two (2) Members of Town Council and up to Nine (9) Members appointed from atlarge in the community.
  - (b) That the membership shall consist of Voting Members (to include Council members) and up toTwo (2) Non-Voting/Honourary Members."
- 2. This By-Law shall come into force and take effect as of the date of its final passing.
